



## Police Officer Frank Bodi



P.O. Frank Bodi passed away on May 16<sup>th</sup> 1999. He served in the U.S. Army during World War II, discharged on June 30<sup>th</sup> 1945 as a Sergeant in the 6570<sup>th</sup> Ordinance Battalion. He was appointed to the Glen Rock Police Department on January 1<sup>st</sup>, 1955. P.O. Bodi served the Glen Rock Police Department with honor and distinction until his retirement on December 31<sup>st</sup>, 1984.

In 1973 P.O. Bodi received a meritorious service commendation for his actions on August 17, 1973 resulting in the arrest of an armed felon wanted for a shooting in the City of Hackensack. While on patrol P.O. Bodi observed the fugitive entering a stolen vehicle on Norwood Avenue and initiated a pursuit into the Village of Ridgewood with the assistance of P.O. Steven Cherry and Sgt. Bert Kerrigan. The subject was apprehended at gunpoint on Paramus Road. During the arrest a loaded Browning 9MM pistol and a sawed off shotgun were recovered.

P.O. Bodi was a charter member and Silver Life Member of Glen Rock PBA Local # 110.
