Lt. Faber was a veteran of the U.S. Navy having served during World War II. He was appointed to the Glen Rock Police Department on December 24, 1946. He was promoted to Sergeant on April 1, 1954 and to Lieutenant on September 1, 1958 serving as commanding officer of the Patrol Division. Lt. Faber served the Glen Rock Police Department with honor and distinction until his retirement on November 1, 1977.

He was a charter member and Silver Life Member of Glen Rock PBA Local # 110. Lt. Faber also served as a firearms instructor was a member of the Glen Rock Police Pistol Team and was designated as Civil Defense Movement Officer during the height of the Cold War.
